Pathfinder: Kingmaker can be a picky game, but it does us a favor in one aspect – the fighter/magician hybrid character is actually very powerful, and it’s the kind of micro-management character we’re looking for in a protagonist. The Smilodon takes the most attacks and deals the most damage, but the Leopard and Wolf have firing attacks (automatically tries to trip if the bite attacks). This whole section, of course, assumes that you are willing to make sacrifices for various fantasy role-playing flights in order to make the combat easier – if not, jump to step by step and keep this flexible difficulty slider! Already at Baldur’s Gate, we had one main goal when it came to projecting a protagonist: he should be the general of the battlefield. Companions come in two varieties: unique and pre-generated characters who have stories and personalities of their own, and mercenaries who you can hire from Amoriel Eyes for a fee. The cost of these mercenaries is determined by the level of your protagonist, and if you are thrifty (and perhaps strategically delay leveling) you will be able to pay a full group of mercenaries well before the end of Chapter 1. They kind of stick to three offensively over time, as they seldom have a way around Harm Reduction, but you can buff them up as your group, and if all else fails, they’re distractions resistant enough to hold the line. Animal Companions are ridiculously good at this game, dominating the early period of the game and providing a useful distraction throughout the game. In addition, they increase their carrying capacity, making travelling over the world much, much simpler. Certain characters take more micro-management, and if you’re not used to it, it can be frustrating. This usually calls for a mage, but for reasons that have absolutely nothing to do with gaming, we’re emotionally predisposed towards fighter/mages, and try to roll such a character whenever the rules allow us to get away with it. Simply put, the game seems to be more aggressive towards your protagonist than most other characters, and a party that wants to be regularly successful in combat needs a good tank. While you can have numerous characters with a diverse array of classes, feats and skills, there are really only several archetypes you need if you want a reasonable shot at success in Pathfinder: Kingmaker – The Tank, The Caster, The Healer and The Bard. This is especially true in Pathfinder: Kingmaker, where the difficulty ramps up significantly by the middle of Chapter 2, and if you don’t make concessions to the game’s difficulty, you may find yourself having trouble. As another stroke of fortune, the one skill every protagonist absolutely needs – Persuasion – fits in well with our proposed tank build, discussed in more detail later. Not all Animal Companions are created equal, and we personally prefer the Leopard, Smilodon and Wolf. Given those goals, this is the party we ultimately ending up liking the best, although frankly if you don’t care too much about role-playing and diversity, rolling up six Sylvan Sorcerers isn’t a bad idea, either. The Protagonist’s Role – Role-playing! It’s the name of the genre! Everybody likes guiding their shameless self-insert on a grand adventure, although sometimes unfortunate compromises must be made for the sake of gameplay mechanics and combat effectiveness. Over the course of your adventures you’ll gain the services of numerous companions, including pregenerated characters with Own stories and mercenaries created by the player. Don’t worry, we’re not neglecting anything; these are just the four that you really, really should have to make your life easier. The other two are optional, but let’s fill them out with two more example builds – The Off-Tank and The DPS. It is of course difficult to qualify as a tank without the fans of spells, especially a first-line one, so a fighter/magician – a Magi – is exactly what we propose. The mercenaries receive only 20 points to distribute among their attributes, instead of 25 as the protagonist. We will try to fit Animal Companions into constraints whenever possible. While the former are definitely more interesting and your journey will be more colorful with them around, it’s a sad fact that many encounters in Pathfinder: Kingmaker are very fine-tuned, requiring min-maxed characters of the strongest variety. These are the four main roles you need, but you’ll no doubt notice that only four compilations are listed there, while you have six character slots. It’s hard to go wrong, however, I think Animal Companions have silly high stats, up to Armor Class 46-49. To this end, mercenaries that you can create yourself will almost certainly be more powerful than the game’s pre-generated characters. The best tanks, counterintuitively, are not always big ones with large shields and large armor, but rather characters whose super-powered players manipulate various classes and prowess to make them untouchable, as untouchable as any character can get.
